Male Urinary Incontinence Sheath – Instructions for Use

Application

- 1. Wash and dry your penis before use and remove any pubic hair. **Do not use talc or creams.**
- 2. Remove the protective film from one side only of the double-sided adhesive strip.
- 3. Arrange the coiled strip around your penis and remove the second film.
- 4. Place the sheath over your penis, leaving a space between the glans and the sheath tube to favour urine outflow.
- 5. Unroll the sheath over the adhesive strip and **gently press** to ensure it adheres properly.
- 6. Connect the sheath to the urine drainage bag.

Removal

Carefully roll up the sheath to make removal easier.

Then remove the double-sided adhesive strip.

Warnings

- Do not use the product if you have a known latex allergy.
- It is recommended to replace the sheath every 24 hours.
- Thorough local hygiene prior to application is essential.
- **Do not overtighten** the adhesive strip to avoid circulation problems.
- Product is **non-sterile**, **non-sterilisable**.
- Recommended for use in combination with the adhesive strips.
- Keep out of reach of children.

Disposal

Dispose of the medical device in compliance with local waste disposal regulations.
